A shared vision in the Global Digital Compact can manifest through clear goals to bridge the digital gap, leverage technology for Sustainable Development Goals, uphold human rights, and foster an inclusive, safe digital environment, and openness to the public.

The Global Digital Compact should integrate principles from the UN Charter, Agenda 2030, and Universal Declaration of Human Rights, emphasizing equity, privacy, accessibility, innovation, transparency, and accountability in digital cooperation.

Critical themes for a forward-looking Compact include AI governance, quantum computation and Humanoid – robotic integration, data privacy, cybersecurity, democracy and misinformation, digital inclusion, ethical AI quality standards development, and international collaboration. The GDC can facilitate knowledge exchange, capacity-building, independent and ethical guidelines, and frameworks for AI governance.

The Global Digital Compact could commit to funding digital infrastructure, promoting digital literacy, protecting data rights, fostering ethical AI practices, engage with international legal bodies (ICC) and establishing collaborative mechanisms for cybersecurity. Actions may include investment pledges, policy reforms, capacity-building programs, and knowledge-sharing initiatives.

Effective follow-up requires monitoring progress, convening regular reviews, fostering stakeholder engagement, providing technical support, and leveraging existing initiatives. Coordination with international organizations, resource mobilization, and promoting synergy among stakeholders can mitigate duplication and enhance implementation.
